

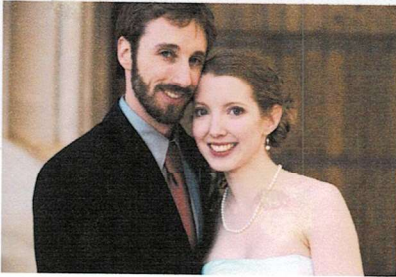

Work... My Fieldworks Language Explorer (FLEX)



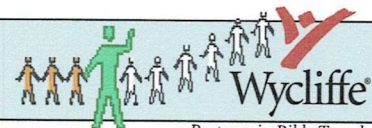
16. **To:** Eric **Subject:** FLEX glossing tab...SWEET! "I needed to quickly interlinearize a text for my students. I used the glossing tab to do it. Effortless! Word ENTER word ENTER word ENTER. Then I quickly typed in the free translations, exported to Word 2007, easily tweaked the output, and got it done. Good job!"—Academic Coordinator, Pacific Area Field Orientation Course
17. Expanded bulk editing capabilities so missionaries can edit massive amounts of related lexicon data more efficiently.
18. Enabled scripture translations to be filtered by key terms.
19. Damien Daspit joined our software team this past year and is doing cool phonetic parser work for us!
20. Our managers need your prayers! They are all swamped and some are in need of more supporters.

21. Total annual giving for 2008 was \$19,986. That is approximately the same as last year, but only 74% of last year's support work quota of \$2,246/mo.
22. God blessed me with increased or renewed giving from three partners and added two new regular donors, a welcomed blessing because four other partners were not able to renew pledged support for 2009.
23. My new support work quota for 2009 has increased to \$3,180/mo to accommodate a married couple in Dallas.
24. My latest pledged giving for 2009 is \$835/mo (\$2,345/mo shy of where we need to be for me to continue serving full-time).
25. Allison's contracted income and the gracious month-by-month giving of a former pledged partner, allow us to pay the bills for now, but I certainly appreciate your prayers for more partners!

Together *we can* provide missionaries software for getting God's Word into the 2000+ languages that still need it!
